Summer Camp Descriptions

Kids Camp - June 10-14, 2019

Youth ages 7-12. This camp will have an evangelistic focus while introducing or continuing a child's experience of the outdoors as God's creation. Campers may or may not be regularly involved in The Salvation Army church and youth programs.

Sports Week - June 17-21, 2019

For youth ages 9-13. This will be a physically active camp. Youth attending will choose 1 sport/ activity to participate in all week long, such as football, basketball, softball, cheerleading, taekwon do, etc.

Kids A.T. Camp - June 23-28, 2019

A camp that is for youth whose families are in the Indiana National Guard. Registration is not open to the public.

Outdoor Experience Camp - July 1-4, 2019

For Youth ages 12-17. These campers will be staying in tents, learning outdoor skills and gaining a more rustic camping experience. Some activity will take place off site. Regular devotions will take place in a campfire setting. Campers may or may not be regularly involved in The Salvation Army church and youth programs.

Sunbeam & Explorer Camp - July 1-4, 2019

Youth entering grades 1-5 who are part of regular Sunbeam or Explorer Troops at their local Salvation Army corps. Youth attending this camp will be earning program related badges.

Music Camp - July 6-13, 2019

Youth ages 9-17. This is a working camp for music instruction including brass, vocal, guitar, percussion and more! Campers are regularly involved in music programs throughout the year at their local Salvation Army corps.

Junior Music Camp - July 9-13, 2019

Youth ages 7-8 who are active participants at their local Salvation Army corps. This is an introduction to music for younger kids, and they will sing in a choir.

Teen Camp - July 15-19, 2019

Youth ages 13-17. This will be an evangelistic focused camp. Teens will have the opportunity for outdoor education while being presented with the gospel and the tenants of a biblical lifestyle.

STEAM Week - July 22-26, 2019

For Youth entering grades 6-12 who are interested in exploring topics related to science, technology, engineering, arts and math. Youth attending this camp will be earning program related badges if they are enrolled in classes at their local Salvation Army, but any child may attend the camp.

Though campers come from many religious backgrounds, all are included in chapel services, prayer before meals, bedtime devotions, etc. Salvation Army Staff members participate in leading campers in these activities and, in addition, staff members are expected to live exemplary lives before campers and other staff alike.

SUMMER STAFF SHOULD:

- **Demonstrate a vibrant faith in Jesus Christ as your personal Savior.** Having a strong daily walk as a growing Christ follower in faith, in commitment and in practice of thoughts, values, words, actions and relationships.
- **Have the ability to lead a camper to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.**
- **Have good understanding of Scripture** and its practical application to life.
- **Have strong love and devotion to youth** – to be excited about living, playing and talking with them.
- **Have sensitivity and ability in listening**, communicating and encouraging towards youth and peers with a positive approach.
- **Genuine love and enjoyment of the outdoors**, camp life and activities with an adequate ability to lead or teach camp skills and activities.
- **Willingness to live by moral and behavioral standards as established by camp rules and policies**, while serving as a camp staff member.
- **Have a sincere agreement with The Salvation Army Hidden Falls Camp beliefs, standards and policies.**

Summer Camp Staff Positions

DEAN OF MEN/WOMEN

Must be at least 18 years of age and have had experience working at a summer camp before. Responsible for supervision, guidance and safety of all campers of the same gender. Must have valid drivers' license.

COUNSELORS

Must be at least 18 years of age. Responsible for guidance, direction and safety of no more than 12 campers. Counselors are responsible for building into the lives of campers through facilitating and participating in all camper activities, leading cabin devotions and building relationships.

JUNIOR STAFF

Must be 14-17 years of age. Will work along side of Counselors & Program Staff to learn the various duties of working at camp. Responsibilities include aiding in the supervision of campers, encouraging camper participation, clean up as assigned, and program participation as assigned.

HEALTH OFFICER

Must be at least 18 years of age with certifications in first aid, CPR and AED. Responsible for health and well-being of campers and staff. Duties include responding to emergencies and distributing camper medication. Must have valid drivers' license.

COOK

Must be at least 18 years old. Cook, clean and serve food under the supervision of the Head Cook.

DINING HALL or DISH ROOM ATTENDANT

Must be at least 15 years old. Responsible to maintain the dining room, dish room and kitchen in a clean and orderly manner, as well as other cleaning duties on camp grounds.

MAINTENANCE ASSISTANT

Must be at least 15 years old. Perform general maintenance tasks under the supervision of the Camp Maintenance supervisor. Must have valid drivers' license.

PROGRAM AIDE—SERVICES

Responsible for maintaining supplies and running errands throughout the camp. Assists at the camp snack shop and helps with general cleaning. General program duties as assigned.

PROGRAM AIDE—SNACKSHOP

Must be at least 16 years old. Responsible for preparing and operating the camp snack shop. Receives money and keeps accurate records. Previous experience handling money preferred. Supervises others in the camp snack shop. General program duties as assigned.

ROPES COURSE/RECREATION COORDINATOR

Must be at least 18 years of age. Responsible for supervision of recreational activities including Ropes Course, sports, fishing, mountain bikes, etc. as well as program duties and teaching camper classes.

PROGRAM AIDE—ACTIVITIES COORDINATOR

Must be at least 18 years of age. Responsible for supervision of various camp activities, such as crafts and games, as well as program duties, taking photos, and teaching camper classes.

HEAD LIFEGUARD

Must be at least 18 years of age. Responsible for supervision of pool area, as well as other lifeguards and program duties.

LIFEGUARD/PROGRAM AIDE

Must be at least 16 years of age. Responsible for supervision of campers in pool area as well as other general program duties.
